Week Thirty Five - A New Community

A Note to the Parents/Teachers

We often look at the ways the early church lived as a model for how we are to live now. There are certainly things we can learn from how they lived in community — but we also want to remember that they did this through the power of the Spirit, not by trying harder. Pray we would see this way of humanity is possible only through a partnership with the Spirit of God!

• **Big Idea:** God forms a new kind of humanity for His Kingdom, and wants us to live in it!

Starter

Evidences of Grace

Ask kids to share ways they've seen God at work lately. Anything, big or small, which is good is from God. When a kid shares, encourage everyone to thank God together.

Partner Up

Have the kids do an activity like building a room with legos (we can bring some in). Then give them the same task to do but with a partner this time. Ask if it were easier with a partner. Why or why not? Ask how much easier it would be if they partnered with God. That's what today's story is about.

Sing Together



Story - from Acts 2:42-47

That day that the Spirit of God breathed upon Jesus' followers and Peter and the rest went out to speak to the crowd about who Jesus was, about three thousand took them at their word, were baptized, and began to follow Jesus as King. They committed themselves to the teaching of the apostles, living life together in community, sharing meals together, and prayer.

Everyone around was in awe—all those wonders and signs done through the apostles! And all the believers lived in a wonderful harmony, holding everything in common. They sold whatever they owned and brought their resources together so that whenever anyone needed anything they could take care of it.

They followed a daily discipline of worship in the Temple followed by meals at home — every meal a celebration, exuberant and joyful, as they praised God. People in general liked what they saw. Every day their number grew as God added those who were saved.

[Dialogue Questions - you may use some or all]

- o What do you think it would be like to live in a community like this?
- o Do you think the church is still supposed to live like this today?
- o How can we? Why do you think the first church was able to do this?
- o What things were people committed to?
- o What things did God's Spirit do?

Breakout Time
